They first settled in Chelsea, Mass.; the next year they came to Trans Alpine and bought some land for a farm, below the Peter Coburn Place; that fall they went back to Mass., and he worked at his trade, painting, until 1860, when they returned to T. A. and bought the Peter Coburn farm and lived there until his death in 1885. Mr. Yelland was a poet; he published a book of poems: "The Exile's Lay and Other Poems." Mrs. Yelland spent the last years of her life with her dau., Mrs. Albert Phinney, in Lincoln Village. They were very nice people and were greatly missed when they left the neighborhood. He d. in 1885 at the age of 61. She d. in 1906 at the age of 86.
